Professor MacMahon has a 30-year track record in academic medicine, specialising in clinical and epidemiological research on the prevention and treatment of cardiometabolic diseases, including hypertension, diabetes, stroke and coronary heart disease. He has a particular interest in the management of cardiometabolic conditions in resource-poor settings, such as rural India. Stephen has published more than 300 scientific papers and delivered more than 200 invited lectures. For his research achievements, Stephen has been elected a Fellow of the Australian Academy of Science (FAA), the British Academy of Medical Sciences (FMedSci) and the Australian Academy of Health & Medical Sciences (FAHMS). He is also a Fellow of the American College of Cardiology (FACC) and the American Heart Association (FAHA). He was made an Officer of the Order of Australia (AO) in the 2017 Queen's Birthday Honours List.

Stephen is also founder of the Institute's commercial arm, George Health Pty Ltd, which was established with the purpose of developing and implementing innovative scalable solutions for the management of cardiometabolic diseases in both emerging and established markets. George Health is a for-profit company that is expected to deliver competitive financial returns to the Institute to reinvest in its research program. Over the past 5 years, the company has donated more than \$20M to the Institute for this purpose. For his contributions to business, Stephen was named EY Social Entrepreneur of the Year in 2013.
